During the meeting we discussed the following:

Completion of the Patio outside Room 3.

Now that the Patio is in place we need to tidy up the area underneath. We agreed to spend some funds on concreting the area replacing the grass which will die due to lack of light.

Burma Road Crossing.

The WA Police department is currently doing a survey on the crossing on Burma Road. There will be 4 surveys undertaken, looking at the volume of traffic and the numbers of people using the crossing. Please make sure you utilise the crossing and don't cross anywhere else especially during these surveys.

Kalamunda Show.

We have been invited back to the Kalamunda Show again this year to run our Burger Stall. This was a lot of fun and a great fundraiser for the school. We will be canvassing the school community for volunteers in the near future.

Burger Days.

We have 2 Burger Days scheduled for this term. Friday 26th February and Wednesday 23rd March. Forms for the first burger day have been sent home with the children today and are due back by Wednesday 24th February. To make our burger Days a success we need some volunteers to help out in the canteen. Help is required from 8:45am until about 1.00pm. If you are able to help out please let me know via the front office. Sorry, due to Shire regulations no children are allowed in the canteen.

Re-Opening of the School Canteen.

Thank you to everyone who returned their questionnaires regarding the re-opening of the school canteen. Based on the results of the survey (below), we decided that the canteen would remain closed as the figures did not show that it would be a viable concern.

Canteen Re-opening Survey Results List.

- 42 Surveys were returned
- 11 Staff We have 34 Staff Members. 32% return rate
- 31 Parents we have 194 families at the school. 15.9% return rate.
- 54 Children amongst the families and staff who responded. 18.9% of children at the school.

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Of those Surveyed: (Parents and Staff)

- 19 People use the current Lunch Supplier
 - > 3 use it once a week
 - > 5 use it fortnightly
 - ➤ 11 use it rarely
- 39 People would like to see the canteen re-open
 - > 7 would use it twice a week
 - > 14 once a week
 - 9 fortnightly
 - ➤ 11 would use it rarely
 - > 1 would never use it
- 12 would order recess
- 29 would not order recess
- 20 people would like to see items added to the menu.
 - > 3 have a large number of changes they would like to see
- 18 people would like to see items removed from the menu.
 - > 3 have a large number of changes they would like to see
- 16 people were happy with the sample menu.
- 32 People would like to see Burger Days Continue.
 - > 5 people are unsure.
 - > 5 people said no.
- 22 people said they would be willing to volunteer in the canteen.

Our lists are out of date due to the numbers of families who have moved on during that time. A new survey will come out during the next couple of weeks.
