Year 6 Stirk Cricket Carnival, 2021

On Monday, 8 March, the Year 6 students will have the opportunity to participate in an Interschool Cricket Carnival at Maida Vale Reserve in Maida Vale. Falls Road PS will be represented by Year 6 girls' and boys' teams who will compete against students from Gooseberry Hill PS, Kalamunda PS, Lesmurdie PS, Maida Vale PS and Walliston PS.

Time/Location

The cricket competitions will take place at Maida Vale Reserve in Maida Vale and will begin at 9.30am in the morning and run until 1.30pm in the afternoon. Students will leave school at 9.00am and return by approximately 2.00pm.

Cost

The cost of the carnival for each child will be \$8.50. This will cover the cost of transport to and from Maida Vale Reserve. **Please place permission slip and money in an envelope, label clearly and return to the office**

Transport

Students will be transported to and from the carnivals via an approved school bus contractor, Lesmurdie Bus Service.

Things to Remember

Parents are asked to ensure that students:

- **Wear their school uniform (GREEN shirt)**
- Have their morning tea and lunch;
- Have a water bottle, sunscreen and a hat; and
- Wear appropriate footwear for playing cricket.

Student Supervision

Students will be supervised by the Year 6 teachers, Erin Burns and Jordan Ferguson and the Deputy Principal, Simon Docherty.

Recess/Lunch

Students will need to bring any food or drinks that they require during the day to the carnival.
