**National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy** (NAPLAN) commences on Wednesday, 15 March, Week Seven this term. Parent information pamphlets were sent home with students in Years 3, and Year 5 recently.

Our students will complete their NAPLAN online again this year. Year 3 Writing will still be done with paper and pencil. To accommodate this and ensure access to computers, the testing period is scheduled from Wednesday, 15 March until Monday, 27 March.

Staff have been conducting some practice tests to ensure that students are familiar with the structure and format of the tests and will continue to do this over the next couple of weeks to support them in adjusting to test conditions.

At the same time our Year 4 and Year 6 students will be doing their NAPLAN test from a previous year to monitor their progress and identify any areas which may require a continued focus.

# **Faction Swimming Carnival**



The Faction Swimming Carnival will be held on Friday, 10 March (Friday, Week 6) at the Kalamunda Water Park. There will be swimming races (25 metres and 50 metres) for the students in Year 4 – Year 6.

The students in Year 3 along with those students in Year 4 - 6 that are not swimming in races will get to take part in a range of activities in the small pool and on the grassed area nearby.

All students in Years 3 - 6 are expected to participate in the Faction Swimming Carnival. Parents are invited to come along, but are reminded that there is a **\$3 spectator fee** for the carnival.

#### Kaarakin Art Incursion

Students from Year 2 — Year 6 will have the opportunity to see a black cockatoo up close when the Kaarakin Black Cockatoo Sanctuary brings a 'Baudin's' black cockatoo in for students to learn about as part of their Art program for this term. This experience will offer students the opportunity to meet and interact with an endangered animal and learn about these beautiful species of birds. Students will create papier mache, watercolour and mixed media artworks depicting these iconic Western Australian birds.
